

HOW TO ANSWER SHORT ANSWER QUESTIONS

Example (<http://mrslorber.weebly.com/how-to-answer-open-ended-questions.html>):

Question: What are the three major predators of kangaroos?

Correctly stated answer: The three major predators of kangaroos are people, dingoes, and crocodiles.

Incorrectly stated answer: People, dingoes, and crocodiles

Here's a checklist:

1. Read the whole question carefully.

- Some questions have more than one question.

2. Think about what the question is asking you and where that information is in the passage.

3. Write your answer.

- Write in complete sentences.
- Use part of the question stem in your answer.
- Include evidence (details and examples) from the passage to support your answer.

4. Reread the question. Then reread your answer.

- Make sure you answered the question(s) completely.
- Make sure your answer makes sense.
