A Message From The Director

JULY! Summer is coming in hot and sizzling!

For those of you who are reading 20 minutes or more daily and continue with your tutoring! Rock on! Students who take the summer off of schooling and tutoring lose up to 37% of what they learned in the last school year. We want our students to go back to school having retained knowledge and learned how to read and do math better than ever!

Reminder: Our **SUMMER office hours** 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Thursday. Fridays, we are open 8:00 am to 2:00 pm.

Our Adult English Language Learner (ELL) Program is officially starting on July 1! We're looking for volunteers and students! Please contact the office to set up a screening appointment if you are an Adult English Language Learner! If you would like to tutor these adults, it does not require you to speak their language. Horry County Schools reports there are over 50 languages being spoken as primary language. This program is for adults only and is designed to meet their needs, in particular for those who read very little English.

We need volunteers! If you know anyone willing to give 2 hours a week to change a child's or adult's life, this is their chance! We have nearly 40 students waiting for a tutor! We ask our volunteers to attend a **Volunteer Orientation and Training** (see the dates in the newsletter).

It is a two-hour training session, which gives you an overview of the organization and how tutoring works. We review the materials in depth with our volunteers when they are paired with a student. If you want to teach someone how to read or do math and be a mentor, this is your opportunity!


